SURVEY RESULTS:

OBJECTIVE #1: Discuss Current Loss Control Concerns for Fire Districts.

I met Administrator Marini at the fire station on Sweetmans Lane. He reported there have been no significant changes to the District's operations since my last visit.

Administrator Marini reported the District has not had a firefighter injury since my last visit but has had two motor vehicle crashes. We discussed the circumstances of each.

I encourage leaders of the District to attend a virtual MSI LIVE Accident Investigation class provided. There are forms, model procedures, and video briefings on investigating slip-trip injuries and lifting/carrying injuries on the MSI Fire & EMS Injury Investigation webpage.

NJPEOSH identified fire departments as a focus for inspections. We discussed common issues found by inspectors:

 Written programs, such as Exposure Control and Hazard Communication, should be reviewed and updated if needed. Model policies are available on the MSI website.

This report does not and is not intended to address every loss potential, but covers only those conditions specifically examined at time of the survey. There may be other conditions not examined or brought to our attention at the time of this survey, that may contain a potential for liability. This report does not include matters of a legal nature or violations of any federal, state or local statute, ordinance or regulation, except as specifically noted in the report.

- Ensure initial and refresher training for firefighters and EMTs are up-to-date.
- Ensure inspection-testing-maintenance records of turnout gear, ground and aerial ladders, apparatus pumps, hose, and SCBA refill stations are accessible.
- Ensure injury logs are available.

We discussed two employment risk control strategies:

- Administrator Marini reported motor vehicle records are checked annually.
- Cyber security is a significant concern for the fire and EMS services. The District has an IT consultant. I encourage the District to have the consultant review the MEL's Cyber Risk Control webpage.

The First Responder Joint Insurance Fund and MSI provide many informational and training resources:

- The MEL Safety Institute created a new <u>Fire Service webpage</u> that conveniently puts many resources in one location. New resources are added periodically. I encourage every firefighter to download the MEL app. An app push alerts users to new resources.
- <u>MSI_LIVE</u> features real-time, instructor-led classes both in-person and virtually. Instructors provide an interactive experience for learners on a broad spectrum of safety and risk control topics. MSI_LIVE classes relevant to the fire service include:
 - o Bloodborne Pathogen and Bloodborne Pathogen Administrator
 - o CEVO-Fire
 - o Introduction to Communication Skills
 - o Employee Conduct and Workplace Violence

Three or four classes are offered each day. See the MSI Catalog for a complete list of courses.

The MEL Safety Institute (MSI) has created the MSI Leadership Academy for Managers, Administrators, Department Heads, and Supervisors interested in sharpening and expanding communication, conflict resolution, stress management, and team-building skills. The program aims to enhance leadership skills by offering participants varied and in-depth managerial training. For additional information, please visit MSI Leadership Academy.

• MSI NOW is a free streaming video service and online classes available through the MEL Safety Institute (MSI) Learning Management System. Approximately 200 titles are currently available in the MSI NOW College. Defensive Driving (DDC-4) class is now among those available online.


