

Waiting on a replacement of the lamination module for the Fargo DTC4500.


The firmware on the wireless access points for the network were updated.

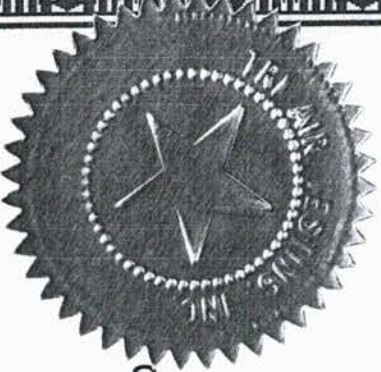


