Sta.16-1 & 32-1 ,will be included with 26-2 on fire calls.

Chairman Hogan spoke with Chief Keaney regarding Problems occasionally on not responding to fire calls ,with lack of Drivers. We possibly need to hire part time paid drivers . Open discussion with people present.

Chairman Hogan suggested that a Committee should be formed of Five people, to discuss / gather info for setting up guidelines ,job descriptions to hire perdeim drivers /hourly ,part time drivers. Chairman Hogan asked if anyone interested on being on the Committee . Committee consists of Marini, Keaney , Tom Kirkland ,Primiano & Hogan.

The draft copy of our 2018 Fire District Budget , was discussed line by line , deleting monies where possible to keep the Budget at a low amount for Tax purposes.


