CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN

Be it resolved by the Board of Fire Commissioners Fire District No. 2 of the Township of Manalapan, County of Monmouth, that for the year 2017, the following shall serve as the cash management plan of the Manalapan Township Fire District No. 2.

1. Cash Management and Investment Objectives

The Manalapan Township Fire District No. 2 objectives in this area are:

- A. Preservation of capital.
- B. Adequate safekeeping of assets.
- C. Maintenance of liquidity to meet operating needs.
- D. Diversification of the District's portfolio to minimize risks associated with individual investments.
- E. Investment of assets in accordance with State and Federal Laws and regulations.

2. Designation of Official Depositories

- The following Government Unit Depository Protection Act (GUDPA) approved banks are authorized depositories for deposit of funds: Brunswick Bank & Trust.
- 2. Designated official depositories are required to submit to the Treasurer a copy of the Governmental Unit Deposit Protection Act Notification of eligibility, which is filed semi-annually with the Department of Banking each June 30th and December 31st of each year.
- 3. Designated official depositories are required to submit to the Treasurer a copy of the institution's "Annual Report" on an annual basis.

3. Designation of Security Broker/Dealers

1. The following are approved security broker/dealers: None

4. Cash Management

- 1. All funds shall be deposited within 48 hours of receipt in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15.
- 2. The Treasurer shall minimize the possibility of idle cash accumulating in accounts by assuring that the amounts in excess of negotiated compensating balances are kept in interest bearing accounts or promptly swept into the investment portfolio.
- 3. The method of calculating banking fees and compensating balances shall be reviewed on a monthly basis.
- 4. Investment decisions shall be guided by the cash flow projections prepared by the Treasurer.

5. Permissible Investments

- 1. Bonds or other obligations of the United States of America or obligations guaranteed by the United States of America.
- 2. Government money market mutual funds.
- 3. Any federal agency or instrumentality obligation authorized by Congress that matures within 397 days form the date of purchase, and has a fixed rate of interest not dependent on any index or external factors.
- 4. Bonds or other obligations of the local unit or school districts of which the local unit is a part of.
- 5. Any other obligations with maturities not exceeding 397 days, as permitted by the Division of Investments.
- 6. Local government investment pools.
- 7. New Jersey State Cash Management Fund.
- 8. Repurchase agreements of fully collateralized securities.

6. Authority for Investment Management

1. The Treasurer is authorized and directed to make investments on behalf of the District. All investment decisions shall be consistent with this plan and all appropriate regulatory constraints.

7. Safekeeping

1. Securities purchased on behalf of the District shall be delivered electronically or physically to the District's custodial bank, which shall maintain custodial and/or safekeeping accounts for such securities on behalf of the District.

8. Reporting

1. The Treasurer shall report to the Board of Fire Commissioners all purchases of investments in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15.2.

9. Audit

1. The Cash Management Plan shall be subject to annual audit conducted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14.

10. Disposition of Abandoned Property

1. The Treasurer shall escheat to the State of New Jersey Checks which remain outstanding for twelve or more months after the date of issuance.

DEED OF EASEMENT

THIS DEED OF EARMENT, is made this 29 th day of December 2016,

BETWEEN MANALAPAN TOWNSHIP FIRE COMPANY #1, with its principal offices at 5 Sweetmans Lane, Manalapan, NJ 07726, (as to Lot 18.01) and MANALAPAN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, with its principal offices at 5 Sweetmans Lane, Manalapan, NJ 07726 (as to Lot 23), hereinafter collectively referred to as "Grantor,"

AND

RACEWAY REALTY, LLC, with the right to assign and transfer all of the rights of this Easement to the Western Monmouth Utilities Authority, with offices at 1411 Stelton Road, Piscataway, NJ 08854, hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee".

WITNESSETH, that the Grantor, in consideration of ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR, and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey to the Grantee, an easement across the property in the Township of Marlboro, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, being part of the premises designated as follows:

Lots 18.01 and 23, Block 79, Manalapan Township, Monmouth County, New Jersey.

Said Easement area is described in the attached Schedule "A'' (metes and bounds description), and Schedule "B'' (Sanitary Sewer Easement Map).

The Easement herein granted and conveyed by the Grantor to the Grantee gives the Grantee the right to construct, maintain, replace, or supplement sewerage and appurtenant facilities on or under the surface of the said premises without need of notice, insofar as such right of access is necessary to the property use of any right granted herein, on the condition that the Grantee, its successors and/or assigns, after doing any work on the premises, shall restore the premises substantially to its original condition, to the extent possible.

The Grantor delivers and conveys this easement in reliance upon the Grantee's promise to install, at the Grantee's sole cost and expense, sanitary sewer lateral lines from the sanitary sewer line to be installed within the easement area to: (a) the primary building located on the Grantor's property (firehouse); and (b) the ancillary building located on the Grantor's property (storage building). The Grantee agrees to complete the installation of the lateral service lines to a point no less than five (5) feet from the outside walls of the structures. The actual plumbing connection of the Grantor's buildings to the

laterals shall be the responsibility of the Grantor. The installation by the Grantee of the laterals shall be done by the Grantee's contractors simultaneously with the installation of the sewer line within the easement area. The Grantee's responsibilities shall include the restoration of any portions of the Grantor's property to its original condition, to the extent possible.

With respect to the Easement herein granted, the Grantor, its heirs and assigns, shall have the right to surface use of said premises, but agree to be limited as follows:

No obstruction or encumbrance, physical or otherwise, shall be placed in or about the said premises which will obstruct the Grantee's purposes as expressed herein. This prohibition includes, but is not limited to, the planting of trees, placement of permanent structures, the storage of permanent structures, the storage of materials, or the erection of fencing. Sidewalks, curbs, parking lots and driveways shall be permitted.

The Easement described herein is in accordance with a map entitled "Sanitary Easement Map, Manalapan Township Fire Company, Block 79, Lots 18.01 & 23 - Sweetmans Lane, Manalapan Township, Monmouth County, New Jersey'', prepared by Delaware-Raritan Engineering, Inc., dated August 14, 2013.

The Grantor promises that the Grantor has done no act to encumber the property. This promise is known as a "covenant as to grantor's acts" (N.J.S.A. 46:4-6).


